

What are they exploring ? They are exploring the sky.


Why ? What do they want to discover ?

They want to find information about the weather. They want to predict the weather (meteorology).

Why do people explore ? We can think of four main reasons. Can you find them ?

- 1) TREASURE (help : they want to become rich)
- 2) SCIENCE (help : they want to know how things work)
- 3) CURIOSITY (help : they want to learn about the world)
- 4) ADVENTURE (help : they want to do exciting things)

1. In 1802, President **JEFFERSON** commissioned an expedition to cross North America and explore new territory that he had just bought from the French leader Napoleon (the name of this territory was **LOUISIANA**). They left in 1804. To begin with, they were to follow the **MISSOURI** River with a **BOAT** to its source and then reach the **PACIFIC/WESTERN** Ocean. This expedition is compared to a journey to the **MOON** because it was so dangerous and exceptional at the time.
